Strand Theatre History

Sybert's Strand Theatre opened its doors on November 15, 1920, to a capacity crowd of 1,200 people. It was the first theater in Moundsville to offer both live stage entertainment with orchestration and motion pictures accompanied by piano and organ. The masonry and steel-reinforced building took eight months to construct, and Merton A. Sybert, the promoter and owner of the Strand Theater, provided plans and specifications. The building was technologically up-to-date and included many innovations for the time. As Moundsville entered the boom economy of the 1920's, the Strand stood as "a monument to Moundsville and its people" to the civic pride and appreciation of the public."

The Strand has experienced multiple closures during its lifetime, one of which occurred in 1968. The reopening in 1976 was a festive event and brought new life to the corner of Fifth Street and Jefferson Avenue with lights on in the old building and a new marquee over the entrance. The Strand closed again in 1997 and sat empty for many years.

A groundswell of interest captured the imagination of certain well-placed personalities in Moundsville to restore the Strand Theatre, and on December 4, 2000, the Strand Theatre Preservation Society was formed. For over 20 years, an army of dedicated volunteers from the community has worked tirelessly to bring the theater into compliance with all building codes and to create a pleasing aesthetic in all areas of its appearance.
